***Update on COVID-19 Protocols for Domestic Ocean Container Shipping***  
***For April 3, 2020 11:00PT***

**Dear Valued Customer:**

- ✓ PASHA HAWAII LOS ANGELES AND OAKLAND TERMINALS ARE OPERATING NORMALLY.
- ✓ PASHA'S VESSELS ARE LOADING AND WILL SAIL FOR HAWAII AS SCHEDULED.
- ✓ SEALOGIX TRUCKING BUSINESS IN CALIFORNIA IS OPERATING NORMALLY.

**Updates for Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>**

In light of recent articles on vessel and terminal operations as COVID-19 progresses, here's some background on Pasha Hawaii and vendor safety protocols for vessels.

- Vessel protocols enacted to protect our American vessel officers and seafarers include restricting visitors and service personnel to ship's deck and exterior locations. Currently no one outside existing personnel and the harbor pilot is allowed on the bridge or in the interior spaces. Full cleaning and sanitizing programs are in place.
- For stevedoring, we work closely with the terminal operators to ensure safe distancing and sanitizing precautions on every shift, as outlined in the heightened guidelines enacted by the Pacific Maritime Association and Local Longshore Unions.

In summary, these conditions remain the same as prior updates:

**California:** Domestic cargo gate operations at WBCT (Los Angeles) closure for dinner and for sanitizing the work environment between labor shifts will be daily from 1700-1800 PT. Please advise your drivers accordingly.

**Hawaii:** Stay at Home order issued for Hawaii. Exceptions in place include transportation workers including port, vessel, trucking and warehouse/distribution.

- Pasha Hawaii services at U.S. West Coast Ports of Los Angeles ([www.portoflosangeles.org](http://www.portoflosangeles.org)) and Oakland ([www.portofoakland.com](http://www.portofoakland.com)) are open and operating normally.
- The port of Honolulu, as well as the barge connections to Neighbor Islands via Young Brothers are open and operating normally.
- Connecting inland services both on the mainland (rail and trucking) and in Hawaii (trucking) are handling our cargo volumes and operating normally.
