**Delayed Arrival for LHX Cargo/Mokihana – Update #3 5/18 01:00 HT - Revised**

As previously advised in the bulletin of May 13th, we experienced a significant delay in the departure of our LHX service. We now have an estimated time of arrival into Honolulu of Monday, **May 18 at 10:00 local HT**. The delay in arrival will affect the Neighbor Island operations.

As of 01:00HT, the barge connections are as follows:

**Kawaihae:** based on anticipated mainline vessel arrival into Honolulu, we do not expect containers to make the Mon 5/18 midday barge connection. Pasha Hawaii has secured a charter-barge set to depart Honolulu on Tue 5/19 for Wed 5/20 arrival. Update to follow with estimated Kawaihae arrival time.

**Hilo:** Loads will depart Honolulu on Tue 5/19 for Thu 5/21 arrival.

**Kahului:** Earliest loads will depart Honolulu on Mon 5/18 for Tue 5/19 arrival. The balance of the loads will sail on barge departing Honolulu on Thu 5/21 for Fri 5/22 arrival.

**Nawiliwili:** Earliest loads will depart Honolulu on Mon 5/18 for Tue 5/19 arrival. The balance of loads will sail on barge departing Honolulu on Thu 5/21 for Fri 5/22 arrival.

We will continue to monitor vessel and stevedoring operations and provide updates as needed. We apologize for the delay and appreciate your continued support.
