## **PASHA HAWAII SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT**

***Update on COVID-19 Protocols for Domestic Ocean Container Shipping  
For April 30, 2020***

**Dear Valued Customer:**

- ✓ PASHA HAWAII LOS ANGELES AND OAKLAND TERMINALS ARE OPERATING NORMALLY.
- ✓ PASHA HAWAII DEPARTURES AND ARRIVALS FOR HAWAII PERFORMING AS SCHEDULED.
- ✓ SEALOGIX TRUCKING BUSINESS IN CALIFORNIA IS OPERATING NORMALLY.

### **Temporary Vessel Program for LHX Service**

Pasha Hawaii will be making a temporary modification to our LHX Service to adjust to the current volume levels and traffic patterns. The LHX service is our direct sailing between Long Beach and Honolulu that departs Long Beach every Wednesday. **Beginning Wednesday, May 6**, Pasha Hawaii containers booked to Pasha's Westbound LHX service will sail to Hawaii aboard the scheduled Matson Midweek vessel. This vessel rationalization program provides for consistency in regular, weekly service in support of Hawaii supply chains, and helps manage costs as the markets adjust to the current slowed economy.

For our Customers:

- No changes to Shippers' existing process for Pasha Hawaii Bookings, Schedulers or Documentation. The vessel information will update automatically.
- All EDI and reporting will proceed as normal.
- Customers trucking freight to Long Beach on a PORT basis will continue normal FCL delivery and empty pick-up at Pasha Hawaii's terminal operation at **SSA Pier A** facility.
- Cargo arriving in Honolulu will be available at **Hawaii Stevedores Pier 51** facility as normal.
- Neighbor Island connections will be serviced via Young Bros as normal.
- Eastbound cargo will route via our CHX service, with Honolulu departure on Fridays.

This LHX vessel program is a temporary measure that may last just a matter of weeks. We will monitor freight patterns and forecasted volumes and return to full complement of vessels as the markets restart. We will keep you apprised throughout this process. Thank you in advance for your cooperation during these unprecedented times.

### **Reminder: Masks for Essential Businesses**

Both California and Hawaii have orders in effect that require masks when 6ft social distance cannot be maintained.

- ✓ This order will apply to persons entering H.S.I. office facilities at Sand Island and Pier 1.
- ✓ Masks are NOT required for truck drivers who remain inside their cabs.
  - We do support facial coverings for the truck driving community when engaging in conversation with port personnel, as an added safety measure for all.

In summary, these conditions remain the same as prior updates:

- Pasha Hawaii services at U.S. West Coast Ports of Los Angeles ([www.portoflosangeles.org](http://www.portoflosangeles.org)) and Oakland ([www.portofoakland.com](http://www.portofoakland.com)) are open and operating normally.
- The port of Honolulu, as well as the barge connections to Neighbor Islands via Young Brothers are open and operating normally. Select routes on Young Bros will flex in response to low demand.
- Connecting inland services both on the mainland (rail and trucking) and in Hawaii (trucking) are handling our cargo volumes and operating normally.
