For May 5, 2020***

- ✓ PASHA HAWAII LOS ANGELES AND OAKLAND TERMINALS ARE OPERATING NORMALLY.
- ✓ PASHA HAWAII DEPARTURES AND ARRIVALS FOR HAWAII PERFORMING AS SCHEDULED.
- ✓ YOUNG BROTHERS BARGE: REDUCED WB DEPARTURES EFFECTIVE MAY 5.
- ✓ SEALOGIX TRUCKING BUSINESS IN CALIFORNIA IS OPERATING NORMALLY.

**Young Brothers Temporary Modification to Barge Schedule**

Young Brothers advised Pasha Hawaii of the following: *“On May 4, 2020, the Hawai’i Public Utilities Commission approved Young Brothers’ request to temporarily amend the weekly sailing schedule for Maui and Hawai’i counties as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and decreasing cargo volumes. Changes to the weekly sailing schedule for Maui and Hawai’i counties will go into effect on Tuesday, May 5, 2020.”*

**COVID-related Temporary Barge Schedule for our Pasha Hawaii Customers:**

- Big Island serviced via Hilo once per week and Kawaihae twice per week.
  - Hilo departs HON on Tuesday, eta Hilo on Thursday
  - Kawaihae service is unaffected; departs HON Monday and Thursday, eta Tuesday and Friday respectively
- Maui serviced via Kahului twice per week.
  - Kahului departs HON on Monday and Thursday, eta Tuesday and Friday respectively
- No changes for services to Kauai.

**Reminder: Masks for Essential Businesses**

Both California and Hawaii have orders in effect that require masks when 6ft social distance cannot be maintained.

- ✓ This order will apply to persons entering H.S.I. office facilities at Sand Island and Pier 1.
- ✓ Masks are NOT required for truck drivers who remain inside their cabs.
  - We do support facial coverings for the truck driving community when engaging in conversation with port personnel, as an added safety measure for all.

In summary, these conditions remain the same as prior COVID-19 related updates:

- Pasha Hawaii services at U.S. West Coast Ports of Los Angeles ([www.portoflosangeles.org](http://www.portoflosangeles.org)) and Oakland ([www.portofoakland.com](http://www.portofoakland.com)) are open and operating normally.
- The port of Honolulu is open and operating normally. Select routes on Young Bros will flex in response to low demand.
- Connecting inland services both on the mainland (rail and trucking) and in Hawaii (trucking) are handling our cargo volumes and operating normally.
