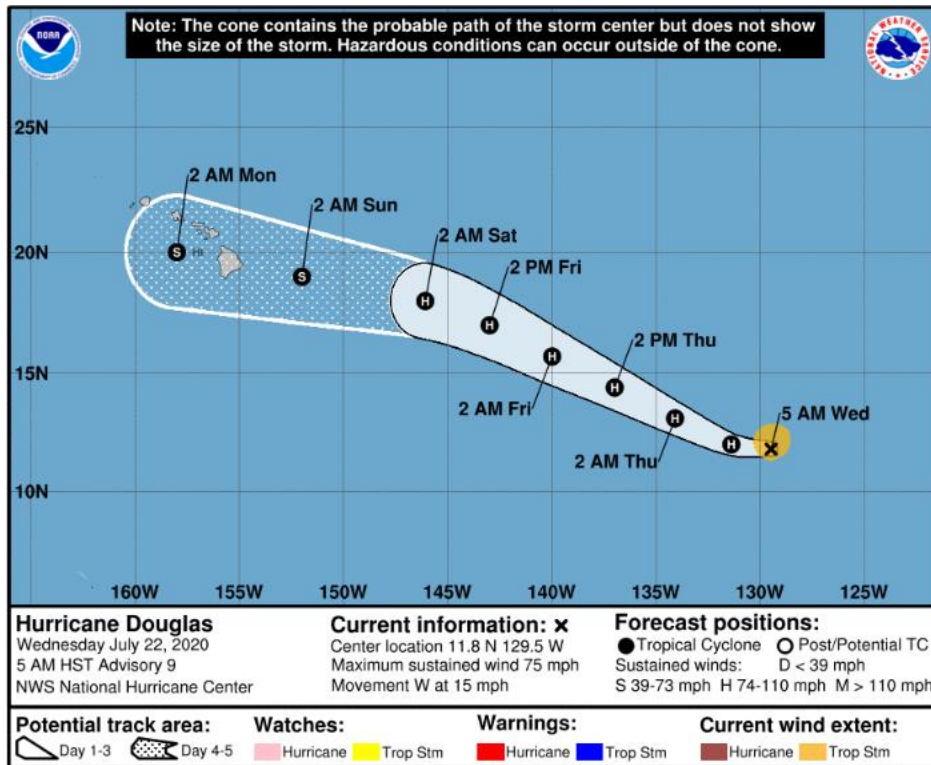


PASHA HAWAII SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT *Hurricane Douglas Update #1 Jul 22*

Dear Valued Customer:

The National Weather Service has advised that tropical storm Douglas has strengthened to become the first eastern pacific hurricane of the 2020 season. Currently located 1,785 miles ESE of Hilo, Hawaii, the storm is moving at 15mph with maximum sustained winds at 75 mph. The storm is expected to turn toward the west-northwest over the next several days. Preliminary guidance has the storm moving near Hilo on Sunday night, Jul 26 and Honolulu on Monday, Jul 27.

Pasha Hawaii’s LHX Service vessel Marjorie C 137W is enroute to Hawaii with a scheduled arrival into Honolulu on Sunday, Jul 26. We will keep you apprised of our progress and advise if we see any potential delays due to weather while enroute, or any updates related to U.S. Coast Guard port status as the storm approaches Hawaii.
