Hurricane Douglas Update #4 July 25th

Dear Valued Customer:

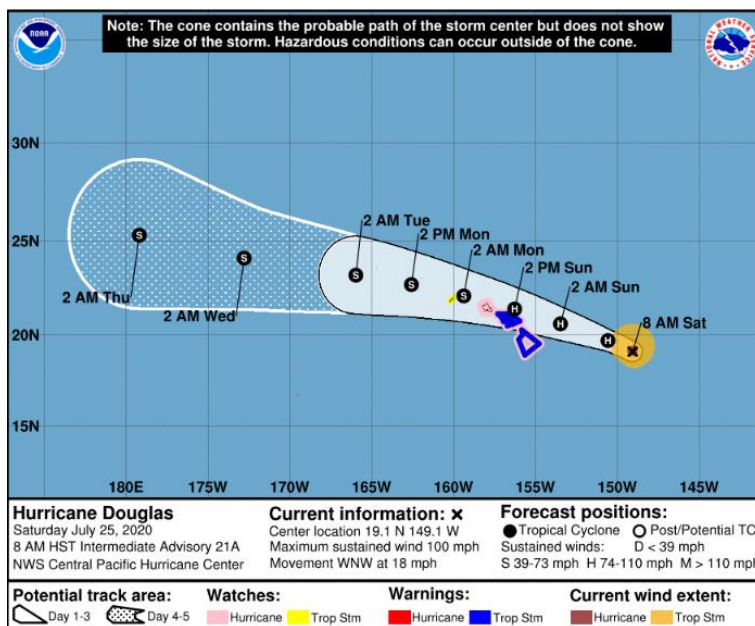
Latest update from the National Weather Service (0800HT/072520) places Hurricane Douglas approximately 390 miles east of Hilo and 590 miles ESE of Honolulu, moving at 18mph with maximum sustained winds at 100 mph. The storm is expected to see some gradual weakening throughout the weekend, however still forecasted to be near hurricane strength when it nears the islands. The U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port and Hawaii Harbors/DOT projects the port of Honolulu will close (Zulu) at 0200 on Sunday July 26th.

Marjorie C MC137W (LHX): The Marjorie C 137W has slowed her transit to come in behind the storm’s track and is tentatively scheduled midday Monday, July 27 for vessel operations at Honolulu Pier 51. Vessel operations are finalized only after the appropriate agency clearances have been provided for harbors, ship channels, and terminal operations; with the safety of our Hawaii operations personnel fully secured.

Neighbor Island Freight off the MC137W:

At this time, we do not have firm departure dates/times for the connecting barge sailings. We will continue to monitor the situation with each neighbor island and provide further updates on barge connections as we receive them.

Barring any significant changes, our next update will be Sunday July 26th.
